

# NOTICE TO COMPLY OR VACATE

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that you are in default for failure to perform the conditions or covenants of your rental agreement as follows:

You are in violation of the following rule:

The following behavior constituting your violation:

You must take the following corrective action:

YOU ARE REQUIRED to cease these violations and comply with your rental agreement or, in the alternative, vacate and surrender possession of the premises **within 10 days of receipt of this notice.**

Your landlord expressly reserves all other rights and remedies for any other defaults not set out in this notice. Four or more violations of the terms of your tenancy in a twelve month period may be grounds for termination; correcting the fourth or subsequent violation is not a defense to a termination for this reason.

If you fail to comply with the terms of this notice, your landlord may commence proceedings to evict you pursuant to Chapter 59.12 RCW. This may result in filing a Summons and Complaint for Unlawful Detainer, entry of a money judgment against you, and termination of your tenancy.

**State law provides you the right to legal representation and the court may be able to appoint a lawyer to represent you without cost to you if you are a qualifying low-income renter.
